PASTOR CORNER THE HOLY SPIRIT ACTS 2:1-12

The Holy Spirit is the third person of the trinity – Father, Son and Holy Spirit who are one and all share the same characteristic as Omnipotent (Lk 1:35), Omnipresent (Psalm 139:7-8), Omniscient (1 Corinthians 2:10), Eternal (Hebrews 9:14), Equal (Genesis 1:1,3).

Jesus Christ in John 14:16 described the Holy Spirit as another Helper" identified in verse 17 as "the Spirit of truth". Each of these two words supports the fact that the Holy Spirit is a Person. Other versions as "Comforter", "Counsellor", "advocate", "encourager", etc.

The infilling with the Holy Spirit also known as the baptism in the Holy Spirit fills us with power (Acts 2:1-8) such as increased Spiritual power, revelation of the word of God, Manifestation of the fruit of the spirit, power to witness, signs and wonders and so on.

To receive the Baptism in the Holy Spirit, the biblical steps are; repentance (Acts 2:38-39); Desire (Acts 1:8, 2:38-39); Activate your faith (Hebrews 11:1,6), Believe (Acts 8:15, 19:2), Laying of hands (Acts 8:14-17).
