PASTOR'S CORNER

Building a Prevailing Church Through Credible Leadership

Leadership is an issue in both the corporate world and in the church. A church cannot be prevailing if the leadership is weak, dishonest, or lacks integrity. In the early church, prayer, the Word, fellowship, witnessing and integrity were in the forefront of the ministry of the church and these were championed by the leaders. They were also confronted with various issues and the way they handled the issues helped the church move ahead.

They were honest in their approach and took clear positions on issues such that everyone knew their stand. If a church is going to be a prevailing church, such a church must have leaders that are leaders indeed. The kind of leaders that a church has will determine the kind of followers; and the kind of followers will determine the impact of that church.

As a church, we are at a critical junction. As we make decisions about our leadership, we must be honest as we decide on our deacons and deaconesses. Leadership is not about where we come from or who we know. As Christians, our leadership choice is about fulfilling God's plan and purpose wherever he places us. One hallmark of credible leaders is faithfulness to God. The early church leaders in Acts 15 were faithful, honest, open and did not play pranks in the discharge of their duties. And that is who we are called to be, so let's pray and ask the Lord to help us as we appoint leaders for our congregation. May the Lord guide us and help us to do what is right. Amen
