God Raises Help in Times of Need

The book of Esther is dramatic as it reviews the story of a woman who by providence became a queen in ancient Persia. Esther was not born in a palace but grew in a culture and background that was least expected for her to become a queen.

Many will think that as an orphan she cannot become somebody in life. Her story revealed she came into prominence from a patriarchal culture where men determine the life of the women. As a Jew, there was no hope for her in ancient Persia, therefore her emergence as a queen has remained a mystery and a matter of what only God can do. Each time the story of Esther is told, it triggers in all hearers the great favour she received.

The event that displaced Queen Vashti, which led to the search for a new queen that made it possible for Esther to become the new queen, was never within her power but of great favour upon a woman from a minority tribe and a supposed subordinate culture. Esther emerged from a background that had always struggled for independence and freedom from supposed oppressors at different times.
