PASTOR'S CORNER

...I will be with you and will bless you...

— Gen 26:3a

God is a God of covenant and He fulfils His promises to His people. In fulfilling His covenant, there are times when the faith of the people is tested either by temptations within us or by trials around us. Each generation faces a temptation. Abraham when he arrived in Canaan met famine in the land and he ran to Egypt leaving the place God had apportioned to him (Gen 12:10-13). Isaac was confronted with the same issue of famine but God told him not to go to Egypt but rather remain in the land and He would be with him and bless him. And God did bless him (Gen. 26:12).

What made this possible?

- Isaac obeyed the Lord's instruction by staying in the land even when circumstances around him didn't look good. You must be willing to absolutely obey the Lord.
- Isaac trusted in the Lord by sowing. As you wait on the Lord, are you sowing your seed?
- Isaac believed God who promised to be with him. Do you believe that God is with you or you are seeking help from Egypt?

God's promise to be with Isaac and to bless him was fulfilled. Be assured that God's promises for you shall also be fulfilled.
