PASTOR'S CORNER ...I will be with you and will bless you... — Gen 26:3a

God is a God of covenant and He fulfils His promises to His people. In fulfilling His covenant, there are times when the faith of the people is tested either by temptations within us or by trials around us. Each generation faces a temptation. Abraham when he arrived in Canaan met famine in the land and he ran to Egypt leaving the place God had apportioned to him (Gen 12:10-13). What made this possible?
