Christmas Reflections: No Place for the King!

Luke 2:7: And she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

The greatest miracle in the history of the world was the birth of the eternal Son of God as man. The event of his birth happened quietly in a stable. Many people had returned to the little village of Bethlehem for the census, so Joseph could not get a place to lodge or a decent place for the wife to be delivered.

The stable pictures his rejection. The inn had space for businesses, the inn had space for pleasures, the inn had space for others to lodge but no space for the King to be born. The stable where Jesus was born pictures his reachability. He is very available and reachable to all (John 6:37).

Just like there was no place for Jesus at the inn, many hearts today do not have a place for him. The Christmas story is to bring many to the stable to see Jesus.
