PASTOR'S CORNER
Directions for Growth
 1 Thessalonians 4 vs. 1-12

This is one of the letters of Paul to the church in Thessalonica. The first three chapters are personal letters while the last two are practical in nature. Paul wrote on how Christians were expected to live among people. Verses 1-12 considered some key issues—the life of holiness, living in harmony and also living honestly. So what is the direction that we need for our growth as Christians?

Walk in holiness verse 1-8

1 —be willing to please the Lord

2-3 —be willing to obey

4-5 —glorify God

6-8 —God's judgment

9-10 —walk in harmony

11-12 —walk decently

These issues are very important and germane to our growth as believers. You cannot call yourself a Christian if you are not living a life of holiness. Paul was trying to run away from sexual immorality because the Roman society was a society full of immorality. Some of the converted Christians came from pagan backgrounds so there was the need for them not to fall back into this sin. Verse 9 talked about the need to live in harmony. As believers, we must live in harmony with others. While verses 11-12 encourages us to live decently. The essence of all this is that the believer's life must be a witness to those who are outside so that they learn what it means to be a child of God. We must live a life of holiness; we should avoid sexual immorality which is rampant today. God's standard does not change no matter what liberal theologians and philosophers preach.
