PASTOR'S CORNER

FEARFUL HEART (II TIM. 1:7; MATT. 6:19-33)

A fearful heart is a heart filled with fear, anxiety and worry. Everyone worries. Everyone has a problem with anxiety however, God is against our fear, worry, and anxiety.

Though, God created us as emotional people. Our emotions are given by God to put us "into motion." Fear is an emotion expressed when our mind alerts us to danger, real or perceived. Anxiety is what we feel when our body is responding to the emotion of fear. Worry is the thought process that mulls over and gives power to the object of our fear.

Fear, worry, and anxiety show up together and feed into each other in the various situations where danger lurks. With God's help, each one of us can progressively improve in the way we fight fear, worry, and anxiety. In our faith with God, we must understand that God is sovereign and mighty, certain things He has ability to do but He chose never to do them in order to show His glory.

Jesus talked about fear, worry, and anxiety often because He didn't want us to lose sight of what was most important in life. What we often miss when quoting verse 25 of Matthew 6 is that the teaching on anxiety is an application of verses 19-24. In verses 19-24, Jesus reminded us all that life on earth is short and we can't take anything with us.
