PASTOR'S CORNER

While he was in Bethany, reclining at the table in the home of a man known as Simon the Leper, a woman came with an alabaster jar of very expensive perfume, made of pure nard. She broke the jar and poured the perfume on his head. Mark 14:3

HOW EXPENSIVE IS YOUR PERFUME?

There is a commitment expected of every believer in his or her walk with God. The level of commitment is an act of worship to the Lord especially when it is done not necessarily to receive the praise of men or to be commended by men.

The story of the woman in the passage is a lesson. She acknowledged who the Lord is and what the Lord has done for her. What she offered was said to be an expensive perfume whose cost is the annual wage a labourer would earn - 300 denarii.

This shows her commitment to the Lord was of high value. Even though she was condemned by others who saw it as a waste; the Lord commended her and saw her act as a preparation for his burial. The woman poured the whole oil by breaking it; nothing was held back.

What is the value of your commitment to the Lord and what are you willing to give as an act of worship without holding back? The first thing you are required to give is your life and then your resources. And in giving, you must not look back by listening to the voices of condemnation from men. The woman's story has become a reference point of deep and sincere commitment to the Lord. What is the value of your giving to the Lord and what will be said about you when you leave the stage?
