2 Chron. 20:26

The city of Judah was besieged by Moab and Ammon other collaborators. King Jehoshaphat was in crisis and so he went into the house of the Lord with all the people to pray and seek help. They prayed and God gave them victory over the Moabites and the Ammonites. In the course of the war, they sang praises to God and they did not have to physically fight; the Lord fought for them and their enemies faced one another.

In the end they carried booty and we are very happy all they did was to sing song praise the Lord, for his mercy endures forever (verse 21). After the war, on the fourth day they came back they gather together at the valley of Berachah. The valley of Berachah simply means the valley of blessing. When we sing and give praises to God; what could not be achieved through prayers are achieved through praise. As you come before him this morning to sing hymns to him, may this lead us to victory may this lead us to celebration of God's blessings and may it lead to victory over every act of wickedness against us in in Jesus name.
