PASTOR'S CORNER**Why Attend Church**

David declared that he was glad to go into the house of the Lord for worship Psalm 122:1. Today many Christians are glad to go into their church buildings to worship Christ but a growing number are not. In fact unprecedented numbers have become dropouts from church attendance. Their reasons for quitting vary. But in light of David's joy in coming before the Lord, it might help to consider some reasons for maintaining church attendance:

1. Because Believers need help to reflect on the past week and see it as just a small part of the journey of life.
2. Because they will benefit from being taught and led in worship by others rather than feeding on a constant diet of their own choosing.
3. Because they need to hear how Believers in the past struggled, grew and live out their faith.
4. Because they need help to face the issues of life and faith as presented through the teaching.
5. Because they need a conscious break from work and self-interest in order to concentrate on the Lord.
6. Because they need to hear reminders of God's love.
7. Because they need help in praying.
8. Because they need to belong to a community of faith that includes others who are try to live out the gospel.
